

METHODOLOGY

The DTM Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is deployed to track and collect. information on large and sudden population movements provide frequent updates on the scale of displacement and quantify the affected population when needed. As a sub-component of the mobility tracking methodology in Nigeria. ETT utilizes direct observations and a broad network of key informants to capture the best estimates of the affected population per location, enabling targeted humanitarian response planning.


LIMITATIONS


The ETT figures reported are not cumulative of all the affected persons thus far but rather provide a snapshot of the current displacement situation on the date indicated. The data and information reported on this dashboard are related solely to the movements caused by the triggers on page two between 1-7 April.

ALERT SUMMARY

Between 1 and 7 April 2024, a total of 1,223 new arrivals were recorded at locations in Adamawa and Borno states. The new arrivals were recorded at locations in Askira/Uba, Bama, Chibok, Damboa, Dikwa, Gwoza, Kaga, Kala Balge, and Monguno Local Government Areas (LGAs) of the most conflict-affected Borno State, and in Fufore. Girei, Gombi, Hong, Madagali, Maiha, Michika, Mubi North, Mubi South, Numan, Song, Yola North and Yola South LGAs of Adamawa State.

ETT assessments identified the following movement triggers: family reunification (407 individuals or 33%), poor living conditions (261 individuals or 21%), improved security (176 individuals or 14%), fear of attack (175 individuals or 14%), military operations (94 individuals or 8%), access to humanitarian services (56 individuals or 5%) and seasonal farming (54 individuals or 5%).







MALNUTRITION SCREENING SUMMARY OF THE NEW ARRIVALS (CHILDREN 6 – 59 MONTHS

Between 1 and 7 April 2024, an exhaustive nutrition screening using Mid-Upper Arm Circumference (MUAC) and oedema for acute malnutrition was conducted by sector partners for 79 children of 6-59 months. Of the 79 children screened, the MUAC reading indicated that seven were recorded in the red category, seven in the yellow category and 65 in the green category. No case of oedema was reported in the seven LGAs assessed.

Among the 79 children screened, 29 arrived from neighbouring countries (4 in Monguno and 25 in Mobbar); of all the 29 children measured; 23 were in green, six were in yellow and none in the red category. All children found with acute malnutrition have been admitted to the treatment programme.
