



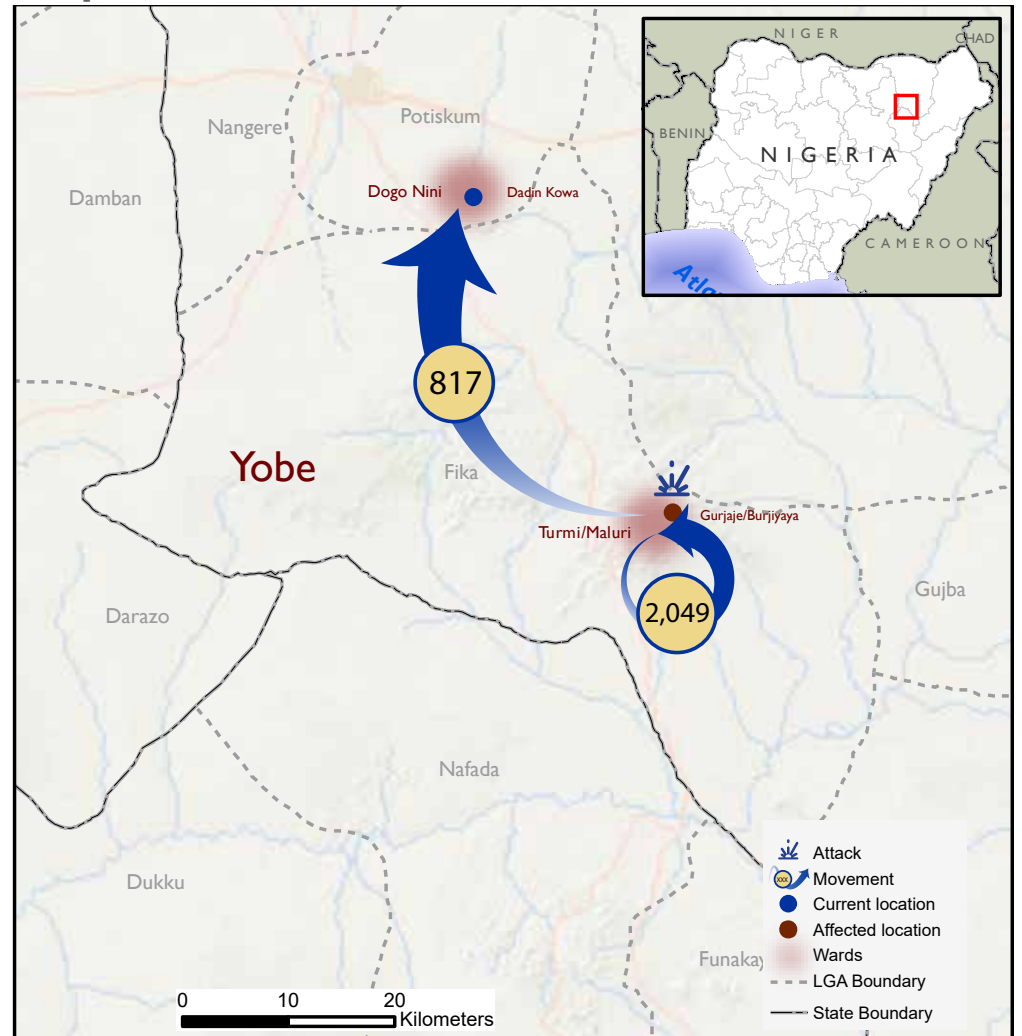
OVERVIEW

The lingering conflict in Nigeria's Northeast region has been the major cause of widespread population displacement. Over two million persons have been forced to leave their areas of residence to other parts of Nigeria in search of safety and security.

On 12 January 2024, a non-state armed group (NSAG) carried out attacks in Turmi/Maluri and Dogo Nini wards in Fika and Potiskum LGAs of Yobe State, leading to the displacement of a large number of the affected population. As a result of the attack, a total of 2,866 individuals from 510 households were displaced from their homes forcing them to seek refuge in nearby communities or makeshift shelters. There were four casualties and 43 injuries reported as a result of the attacks.

Following the attack, the Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) Nigeria, deployed a rapid assessment team to evaluate the immediate needs and vulnerabilities of the affected population with the purpose of informing the humanitarian community and the Government partners, and enabling targeted response. Flash reports utilise direct observation and a broad network of key informants to gather data and collect information on the number, profile and immediate needs of the affected population.

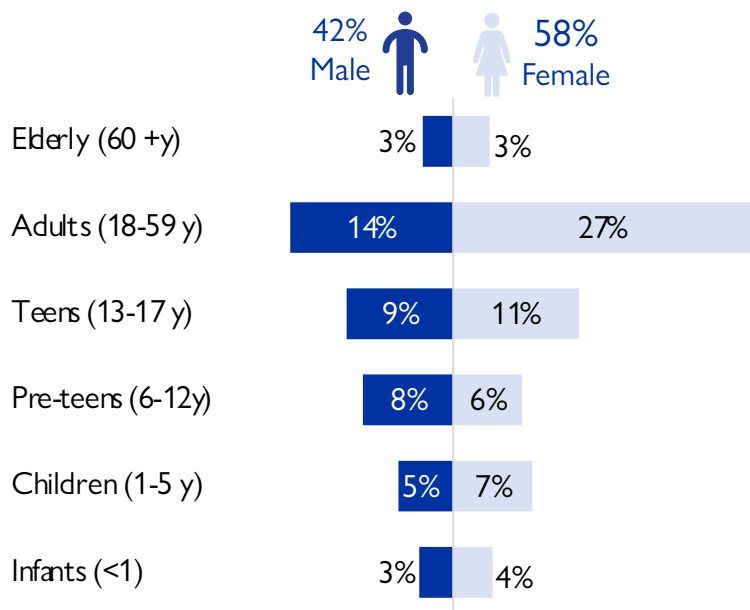


Fig. 1: Gender breakdown of the affected population

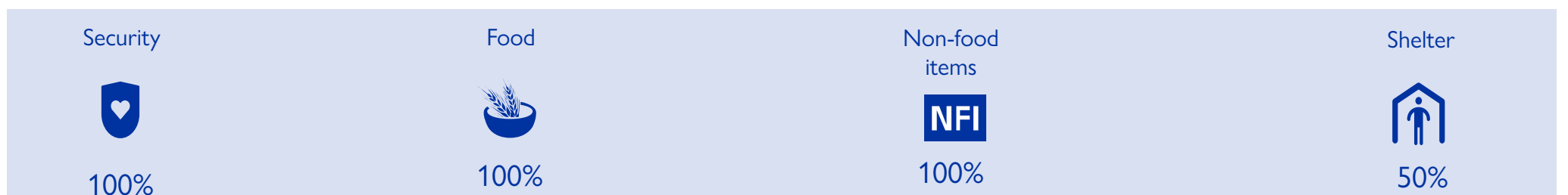


Fig. 3: Most needed assistance [Multiple response]
