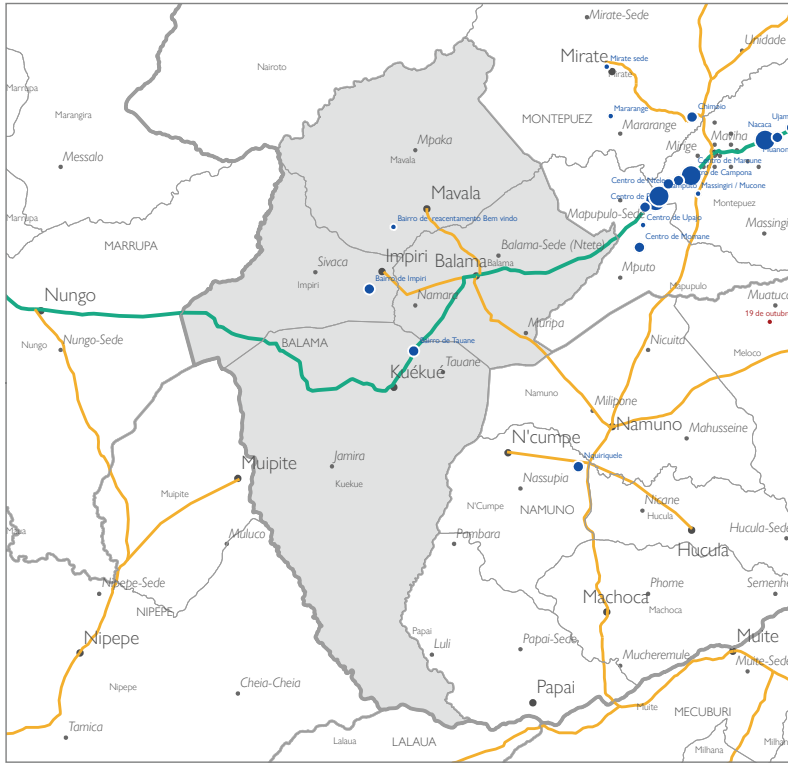


Sex, Age and Disaggregated Data
