






Reasons	<b>Geidam:</b> The IDP population increased as a result of the restored security situation in Geidam LGA in the state of Yobe.	<b>Bama:</b> The IDP population increased due to the arrival of IDPs from inaccessible locations in the same LGA (Gulumba, Soye, Abara, Botori, Alafa, Drajamal and Kotembein), caused by attacks by Non-State Armed Groups (NSAG).	<b>Jere:</b> The IDP population decreased as a result of the Government relocation schemes from camps and camp-like settings in Jere LGA.	<b>Bade:</b> The IDPs returned to their places of origin which are Geidam and Yunusari LGAs since peace has been restored.


