


# IOM Iraq Emergency Tracking: Mosul Operations **DATA SNAPSHOT: 2 November 2016**

# Total number of displaced individuals as of today: 20,808\*


# Number of displaced individuals identified by **Emergency Tracking since 17 October**



- Approximately 800-1000 individuals from Abu Jarboa'a village, in Baashiga sub-district, arrived to Nargazliyah screening site. Of these, about 500 individuals (88 families) moved to Zelikan camp. The others have remained in the screening site because of a sand storm and were expected to be transported to Zelikan camp the following day (today);
- Approximately 150 families on the front line, still from Abu Jarbo'a village, are expected to reach Nargizliyah screening site;
- 97 families arrived to Hasansham M1 (MODM) camp from Baashiga, Namroud, Bartalla and Markaz Mousl sub-districts;
- About 200 families crossed the river from villages in Al-Namroud sub-district to Tubiya village, in Al-Shura sub-district:
- About 82 families were displaced from Al-Shura sub-district to Qayyarah Jad'ah camp. The security screening took place at the entrance of the camp.


## Where are people coming from?

\*Emergency tracking numbers are **not** cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by muliplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
