OVERVIEW


The Registered IDP Area Baseline Assessment provides granular data on the number and geographic location of officially registered internally displaced persons (IDPs). This report assesses registered IDP presence at the raion level, also mapping the recorded change since the previous round. Round 23 presents the data of the registered IDP population disaggregated by gender and age, as well as their distribution for three specific age groups.


The data collected for the Area Baseline Assessment Round 23 reflects the registered IDP population as of 30 April 2023 across 23 oblasts and Kyiv city. In the covered areas, the number of registered IDPs was collected for 108 raions and 984 hromadas (74% of all hromada covered in Ukrainian government-controlled areas). Data disaggregated by age and gender were provided for 75 per cent of the administrative units covered.

IOM's glossary defines IDPs as persons or groups of persons who have been forced or obliged to flee or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of generalised violence, violations of human rights or natural or human-made disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border. Operationally, for this assessment, IOM define and understand IDPs as persons who officially registered as fleeing their habitual place of residence due to the current war in Ukraine.

KEY INSIGHTS

- Among oblasts, Kharkivska (483,186), Dnipropetrovska (379,857) and Kyivska (331,686) have the highest number of formally registered IDPs.
- At the raion level, Kharkivskyi (267,006), Kyivska (246,089) and Zaporizkyi (171,718) host the highest number of registered IDPs.
- The Eastern and Kyivska oblasts host proportionally higher shares of registered male IDPs, while in the Western oblasts, there are predominantly higher shares of IDPs under 18 years of age.
- Kharkivska and Donetska oblasts have the highest share of IDPs over 60 years of age.






Disclaimer: The data in this report was sourced from official IDP data recorded by oblast authorities. As such, it likely represents an undercount of those who have been de facto forced to flee their homes.

CHANGES IN REGISTERED IDP FIGURES

Changes in the caseload of registered IDPs are measured controlling for variations in the area covered compared to the previous round. The map above shows the changes in raions that were assessed in both Rounds 22 and 23.

In round 23, increases in the stock of IDPs registered were highest in eastern oblasts of Ukraine, including in Kharkisvska, Donetska, Zaporizka and Dnipropetrovska, and in Kyiv city oblasts. Conversely, a general decrease in registered IDPs is observed in western and central oblasts.

Furthermore, the main increases in the registered IDP population are evidenced in the southern and eastern raions of the country, including Kharkivskyi, Zaporizkyi, Dniprovskyi as well as in Kyivska raions, with the exception of Lvivskyi raion in the West.


METHODOLOGY

Data for the Area Baseline Assessment is collected through a network of Key Informants within the oblast administration bodies across the country. Every month, DTM collects the recorded figures on registered displacement directly from regional authorities, as well as disaggregated estimates of gender and age among registered IDPs.

DTM endeavors to collect data on the registered IDP population in all territories under the control of the Government of Ukraine. While data collection capacity grows, geographical coverage can change across rounds. Therefore, the change in recorded registered IDPs from round to round is reported only for those areas that are comparable, to avoid selection bias in the estimates.
