KEY FINDINGS (1 – 31 MAY)



Rainfall in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has impacted 8 districts, resulting in widespread damage and disruption.



Reports indicate that approximately 163 infrastructure units have sustained damage in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.




The highest volume of rainfall was recorded in Lakki Marwat district, leading to damages to houses, landslides, flash flooding, lightning strikes, and road closures.



In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 1 human casualty has been reported in different districts, along with the loss of about 40 cattle.
