#### **KEY FINDINGS**



Rainfall in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has impacted **32 districts**, resulting in widespread damage and disruption.



Reports indicate that approximately **4,608 infrastructure units** have sustained damage in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.




The highest volume of rainfall was recorded in **Upper Dir district**, leading to significant damages to houses, landslides, flash flooding, lightning strikes, and road closures.



In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, **86 human casualties** have been reported in different districts, along with the loss of about **561 cattle.**
