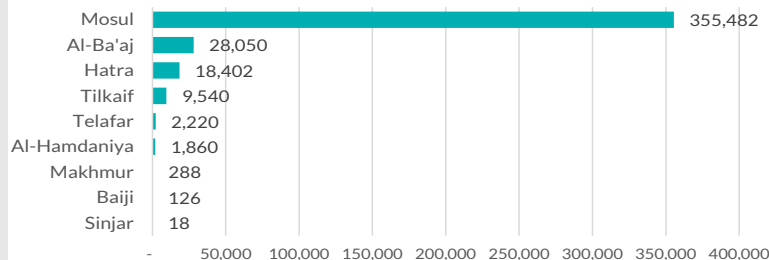

All information collected on IDPs and returnees is included in the Emergency Tracking (ET) database once the locations of displacement or return have been identified and validated. The identification of the locations of displacement of the new arrivals requires some time, especially in out-of-camp locations. As some areas are not easily accessible, time is required between an actual population movement and its tracking and reporting.

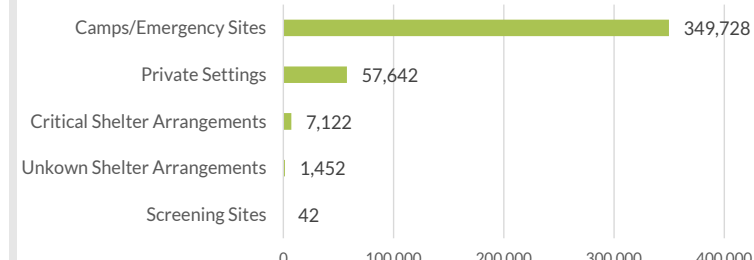
WHERE ARE PEOPLE COMING FROM?

Number of individuals displaced, by district of origin

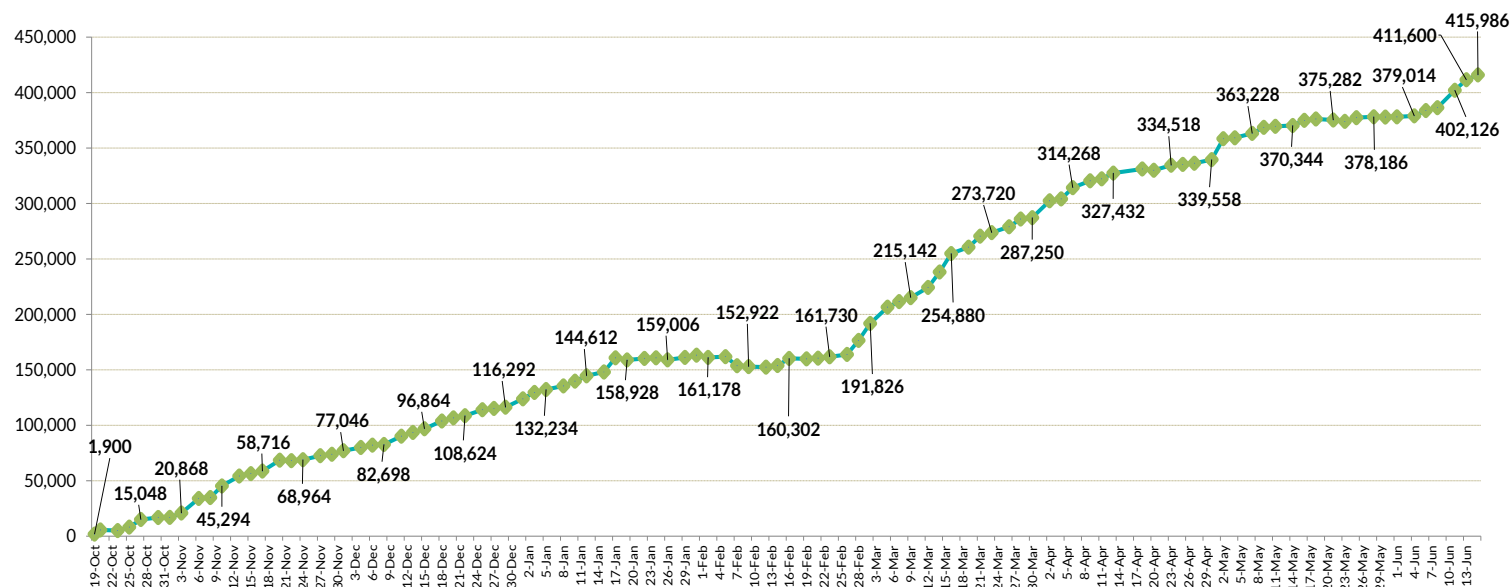


WHERE ARE PEOPLE STAYING?

As of June 14 :

- Qayyarah Jad'ah 6 camp recorded an increase of 402 IDP families;
- The DTM has identified approximately 7,000 returnee families across villages in Hammam al-Aleel sub-district. Reportedly, these returnees were forcibly displaced from this area towards the city of Mosul in November 2016. Their areas of origin were retaken by ISF at the end of March 2017, and from mid-May returns to Hammam al-Aleel sub-district started to be recorded. After further verifications the figures have now been added to the DTM returnee counting.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
