## As of May 27 :

- As Salamiya 1 camp reported an increase of approximately 300 IDP families;
- Sahlej Village, in Zummar sub-district, recorded the arrival of approximately 1000 individuals, who will be most likely transported to camps during the day;
- Nargizliya 1 and 2 camps reported a decrease of 143 and 198 IDP families respectively, due to returns to Merkaz Mosul and Merkaz Tilkaif sub-districts.
