
TOTAL NUMBER OF IDPS CURRENTLY DISPLACED



As of May 20:

- Updated figures about Hammam al-Aliel 1 camp and the recently opened Hammam al-Aliel 2 camp have been added:
- Between 6 and 15 May, according to the camp management, approximately 213 families arrived to Hassansham M2 (former Khazer M2) camp, while 347 left. During the same period of time, Hassansham U3 camp received 134 IDP families, while 174 left; Khazer M1 camp received 281 IDP families, while 384 left; and Chamakor camp received 44 IDP families while 132 left;
- Ongoing field visits allowed to identify IDP and returnee families across different locations in Thi Qar, articularly in Markaz Al-Nassriya and Markaz Sug Al-Shoyakh sub-districs.
