
IOM YEMEN **RAPID DISPLACEMENT TRACKING (RDT)**

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first seven months of 2020, conflict and natural disasters resulted in new patterns of have displacement, particularly in Marib, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, and Taizz governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 16 and 22 August, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (214 HH), Al Hudaydah (28 HH), and Taizz (13 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Marib (214 HH), Al Hudaydah (29 HH) and Taizz (7 HH).


IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

Since the beginning of 2020, DTM identified other also 1.127 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origion or some other displaced location.



UPDATE: Additional 37 HHs were displaced between Aug 09 - Aug 15, 2020, and have been added in the total housholds.
