

DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first eight months of 2020, conflict and natural disasters resulted in new patterns of have displacement, particularly in Marib, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz and Al Jawf governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 30 Aug and 5 September, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (334 HH), Al Hudaydah (58 HH), and Shabwah (51 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Marib (383 HH), Al Hudaydah (82 HH) and AI Dhale'e (21 HH).


IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

Since the beginning of 2020, DTM identified other also 1.170 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origion or some other displaced location.



UPDATE: Additional 543 HHs were displaced between Aug 23 - Aug 29, 2020, and have been added in the total housholds.
