

The purpose of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements as well as on security and climate emergencies. This dashboard provides information on movements which occurred during the period from **02 to 31 May 2023**, in Lake Chad Province .

Since the beginning of 2023, a large number of incidents have been observed in the Lake Chad Province resulting in an increased number of displacements. During May 2023, 1,309 households (7,290 individuals) were affected by displacement. It is noteworthy that the majority of these persons (63%) were local communities before these new displacements. Furthermore, the reasons for displacement were preventive movement (51%), armed attack (42%) and kidnapping of persons (7%). Most displacements occurred in localities within the same sous-préfectures as their provenance. Indeed, 73 per cent of displaced individuals took refuge in localities situated in the same sous-préfectures as their provenances (see table 1). The most frequently reported priority needs were food (33%), water (33%), shelter (17%) and non-food items (17%).



<u>Displaced persons by host sous-préfecture and reasons for</u> <u>displacement in May 2023</u>




Displaced persons in May 2023


